- **Eligibility - For Schools:** In order to be eligible to participate in NSCP-2020, a school needs to ensure the participation of at least 50 students. However, online registration does not have any eligibility criteria.
- **Eligibility - For Students:** NSCP-2020 is open to the students of classes 5 to 12. Based on their class of study, students will be divided into 4 levels as - Level 1 (Class 5 & 6), Level 2 (Class 7 & 8), Level 3 (Class 9 & 10) and Level 4 (Class 11 & 12).
- **Medium of the test:** It will either be English/Hindi/Bengali/Telugu. The question paper will be in the language selected as medium by the student **EXCEPT** Reading Literacy which would compulsorily be in English for everyone.
- **No Registration Fee:** The participation in NSCP-2020 is free of cost. But the school will be **required to bear the operational costs** like printing question papers and OMRs, courier, etc.
- **School Portal:** As soon as the online registration of an institute is approved, login credentials for the school portal will be sent on their registered email ids. This school portal shall be used by the schools for registering their students, checking results etc.
- **Student Portal:** After the registration of students from a school gets approved, a unique registration number and login credentials of the student portal for all the students will be available on the school portal. The student portal shall be used by the students to access study material/ sample papers, appear in online round, check individual results etc.
- **Other Guidelines -**
 - ✓ To conduct the Examination, School should provide at least 8 computers, classrooms and invigilators.
 - ✓ The PDFs of question papers and OMRs for Round 1 (offline) will be sent through email to schools for printing and conducting the exam.
 - ✓ The links for the Online Exam portal for Round 2 will be sent through email to schools or made available on the website around the Exam dates only.

- Any school/student involving in any kind of unfair means while taking part in the exam would be barred and strict action would be taken against the student/ school.
